We hope you enjoy our book, and we can't wait to see what colors you bring to our collections!










First National Bank of Scranton, 1906



Sketch of the Scranton Estate, undated (ca. 1940s)




Thomson Hospital, 1944




Hotel Casey, 1951














Grand Opera House, 1909


Lyceum Theatre, 1904
