We hope you enjoy our book, and we can't wait to see what colors you bring to our collections!

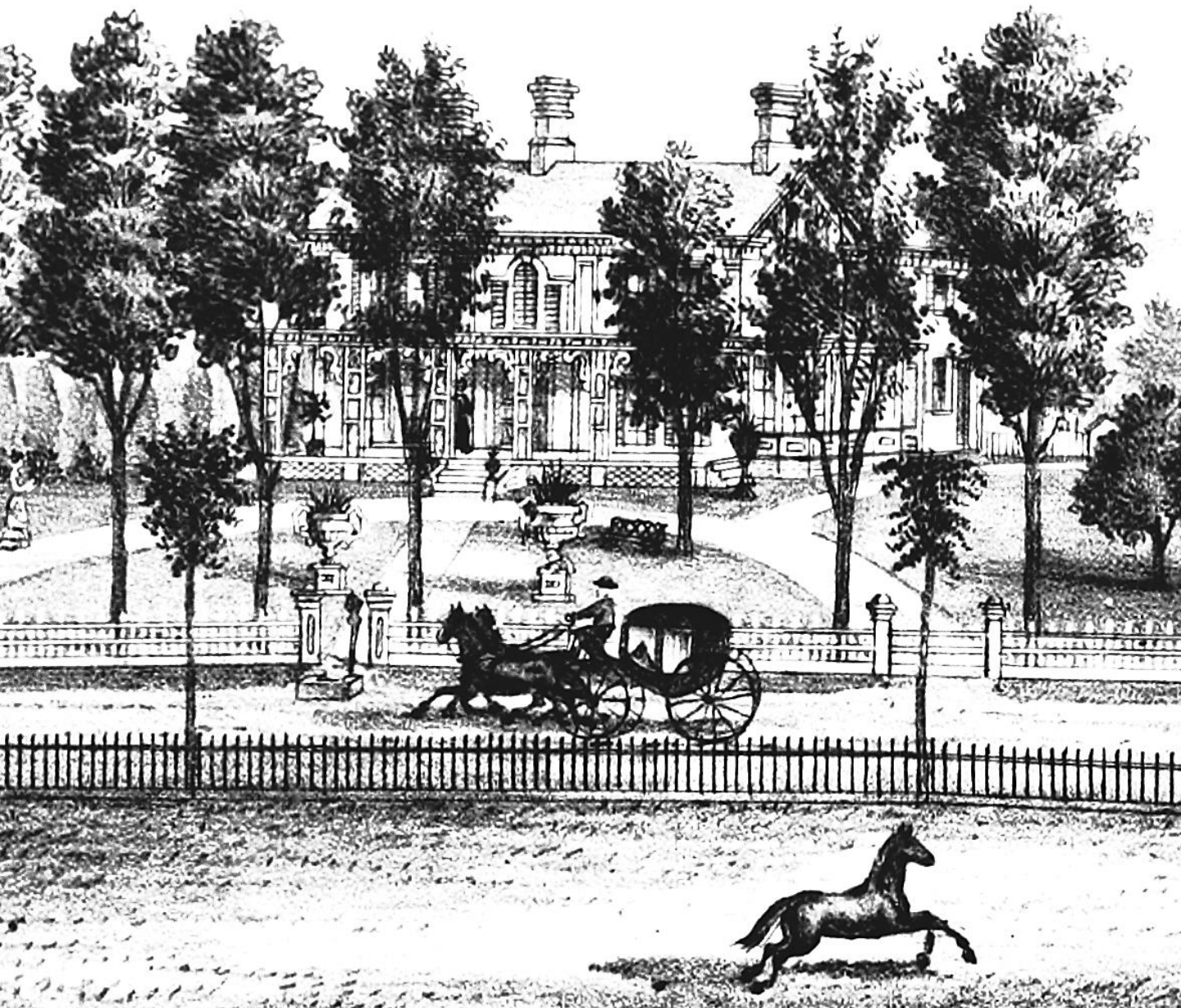

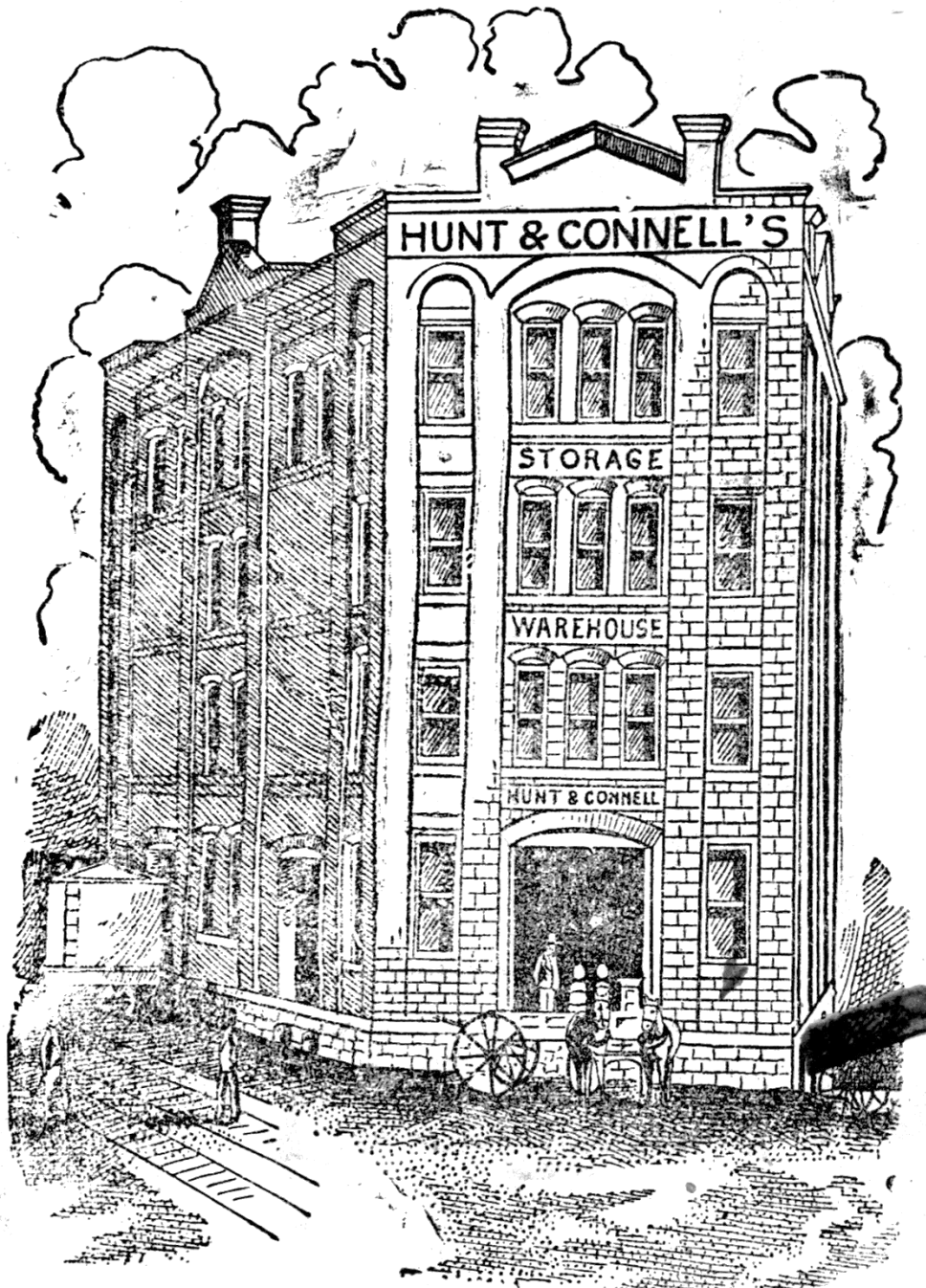

Drawing from *History of Luzerne, Lackawanna, and Wyoming Counties, Pa.* (1880)

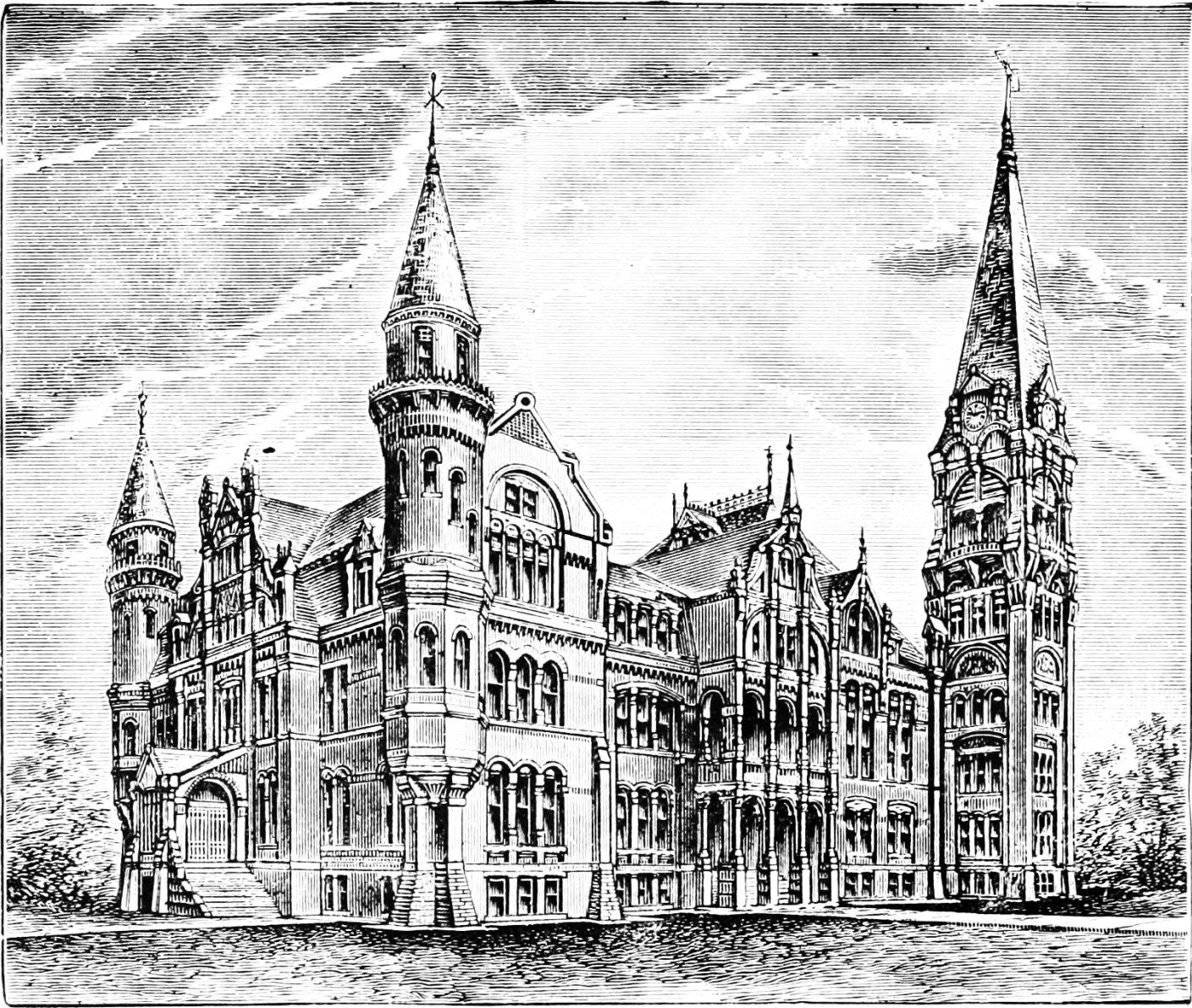

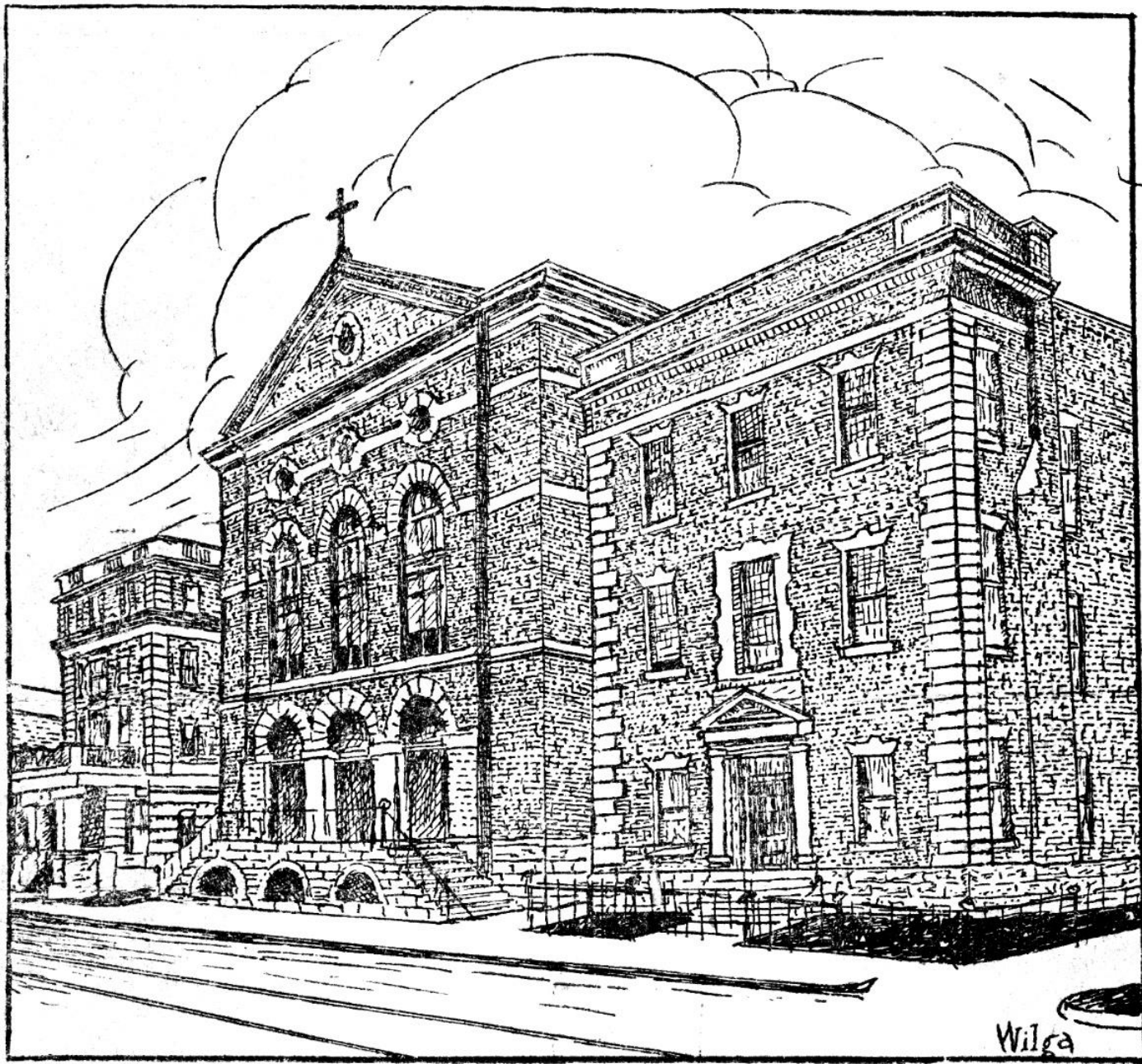

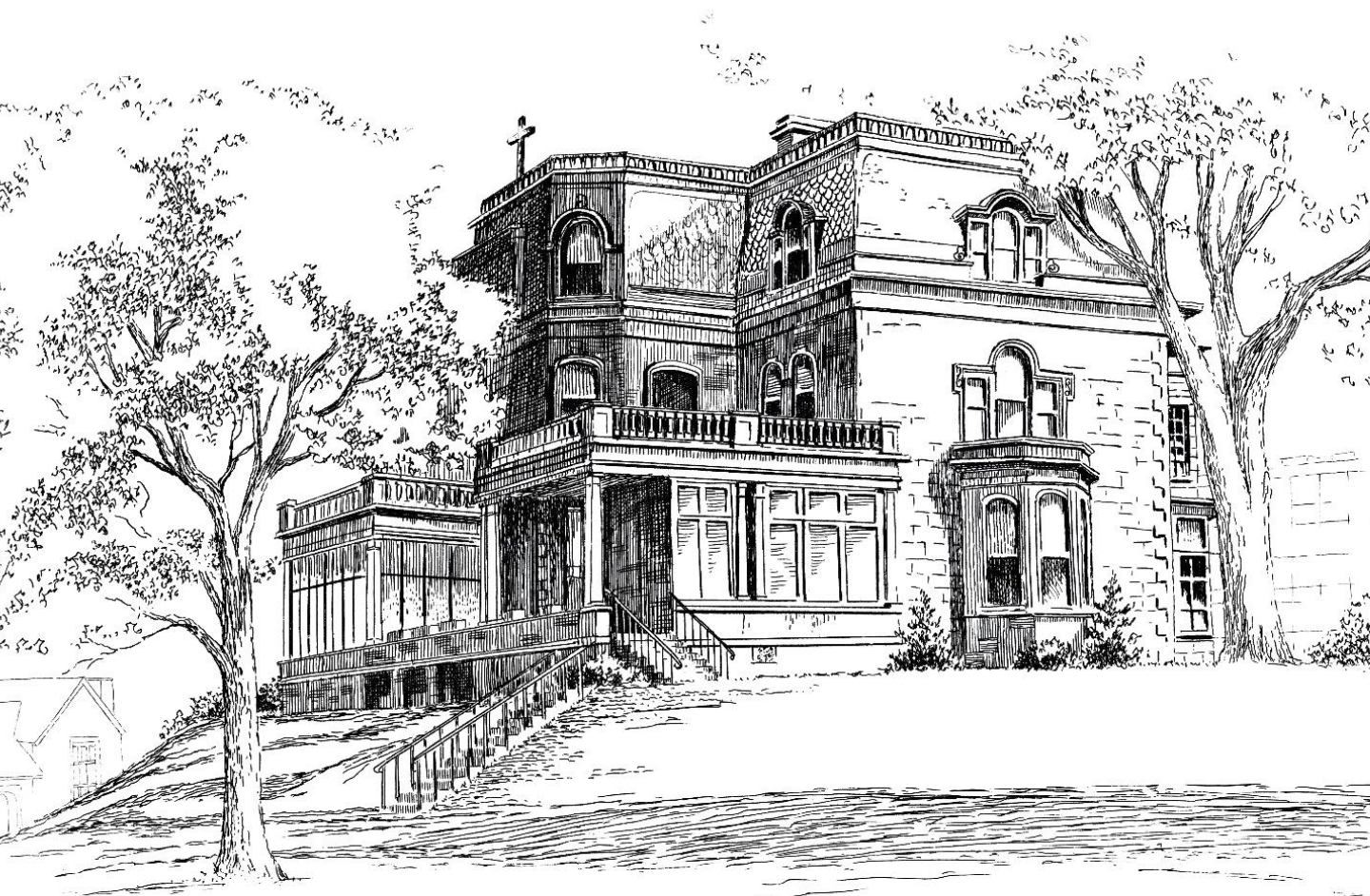

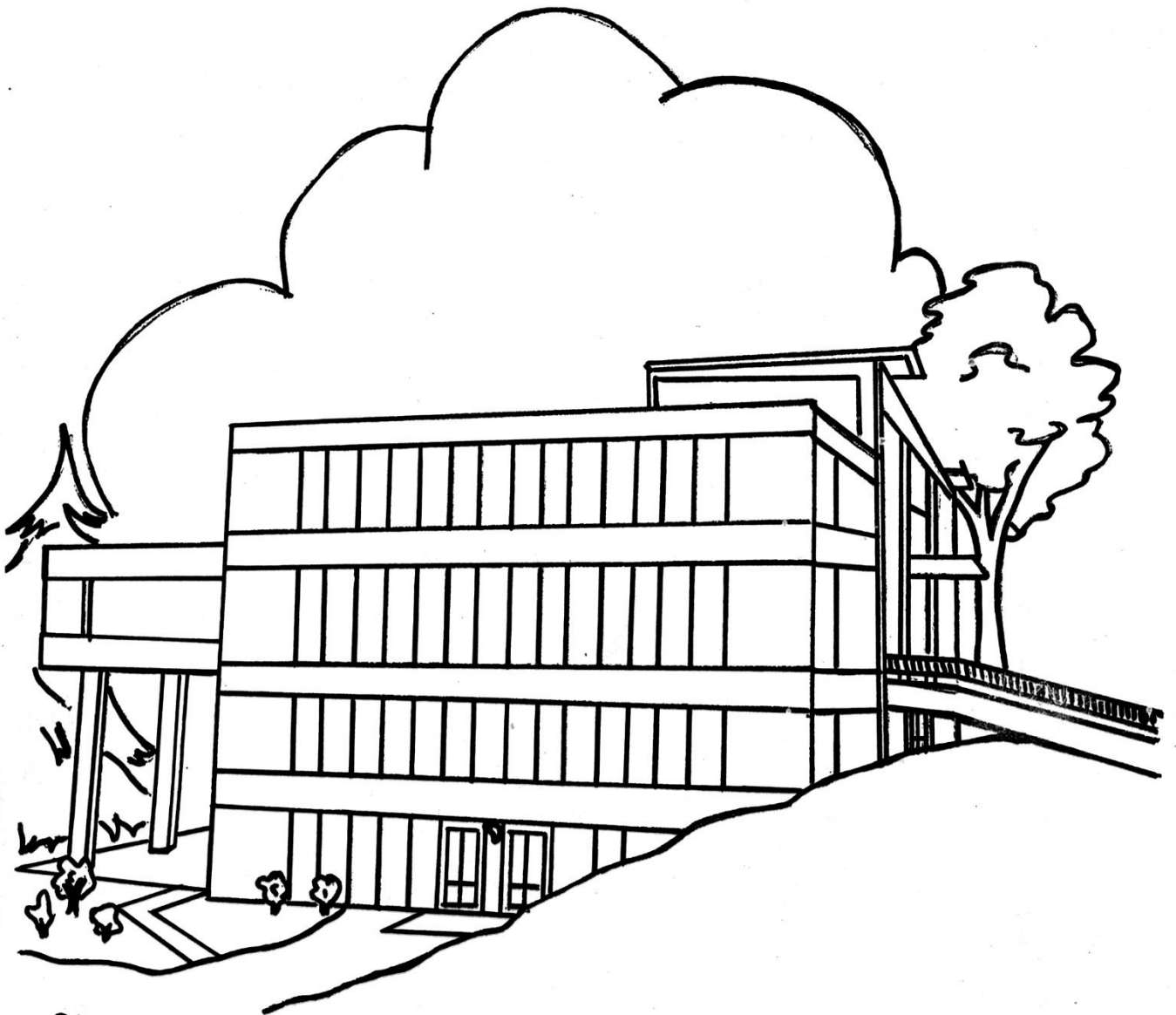

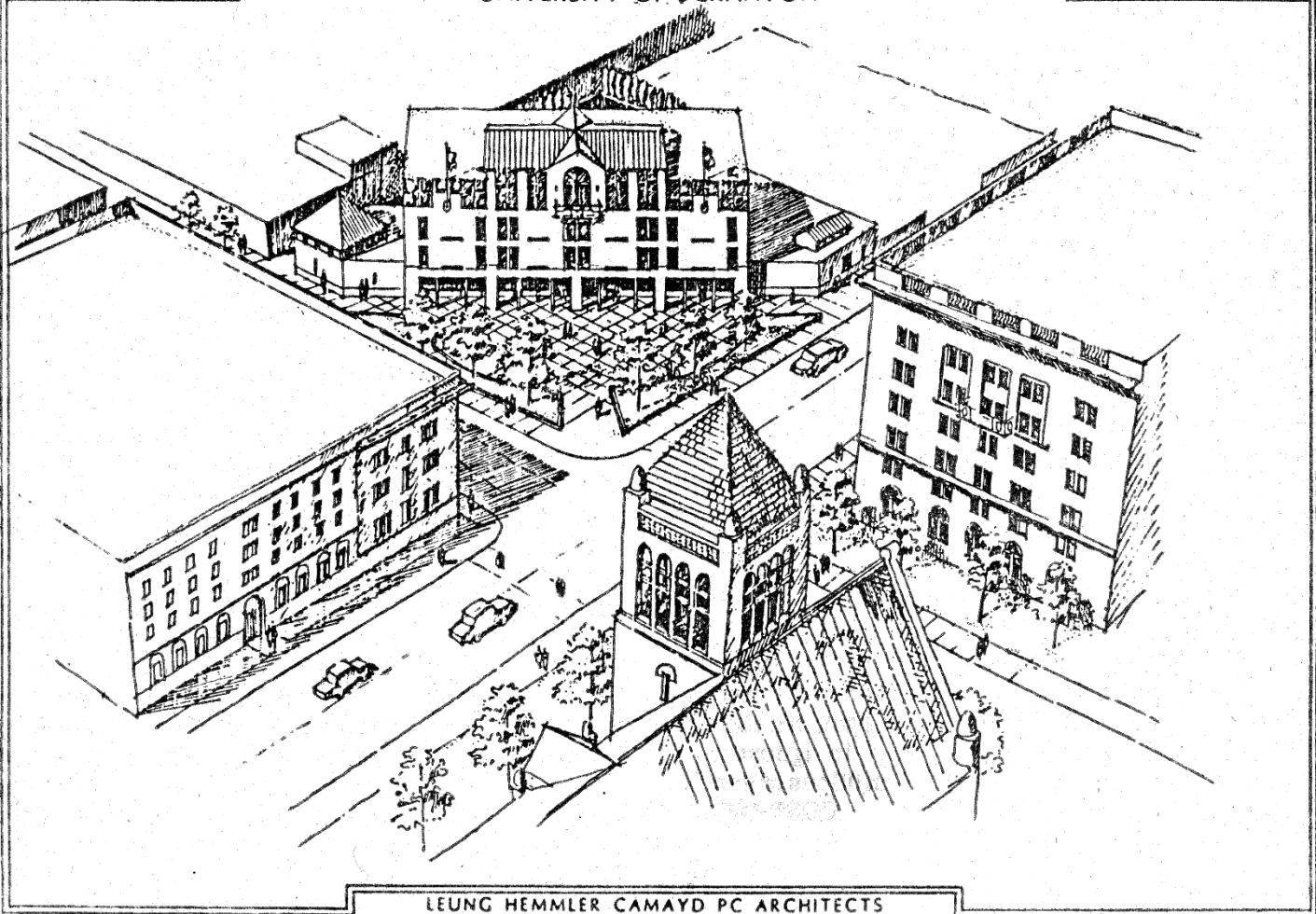

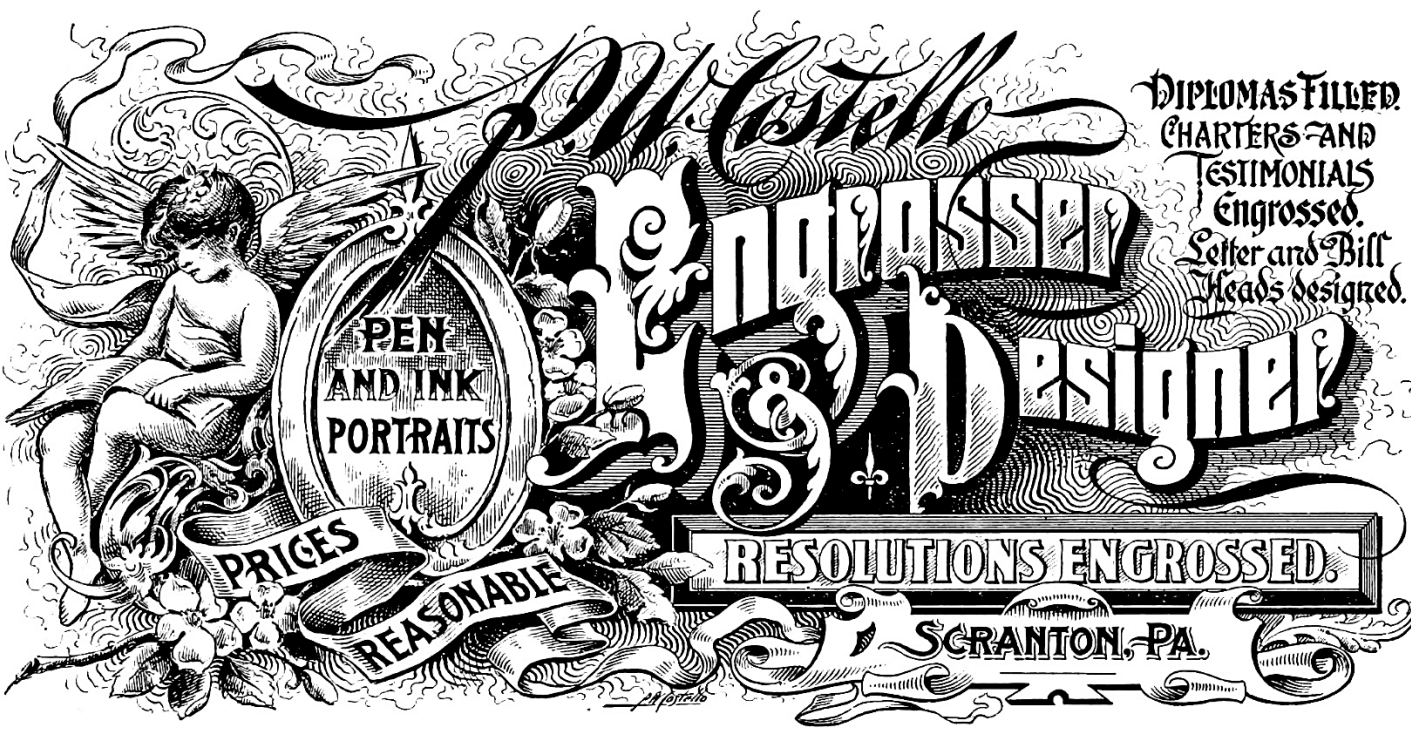

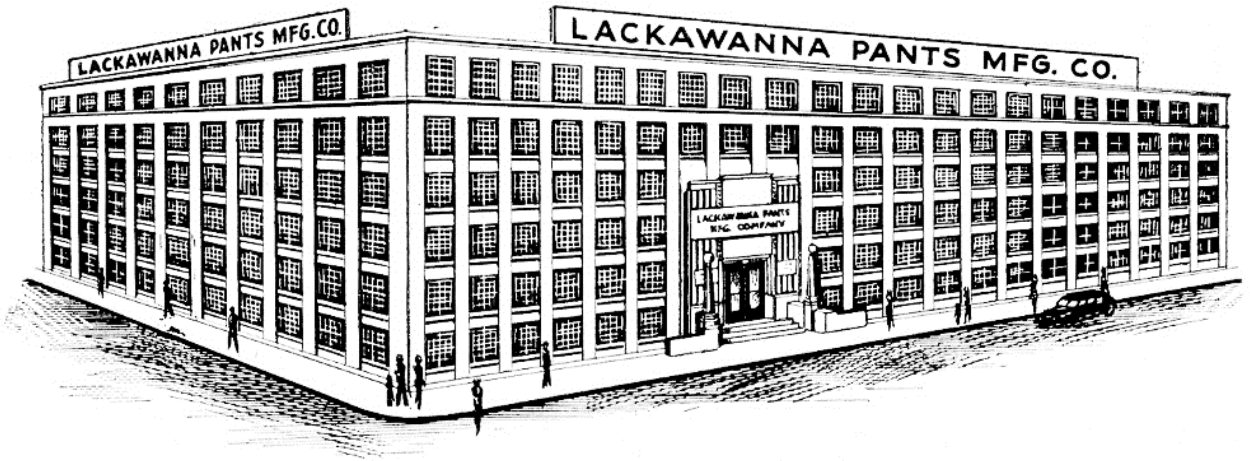

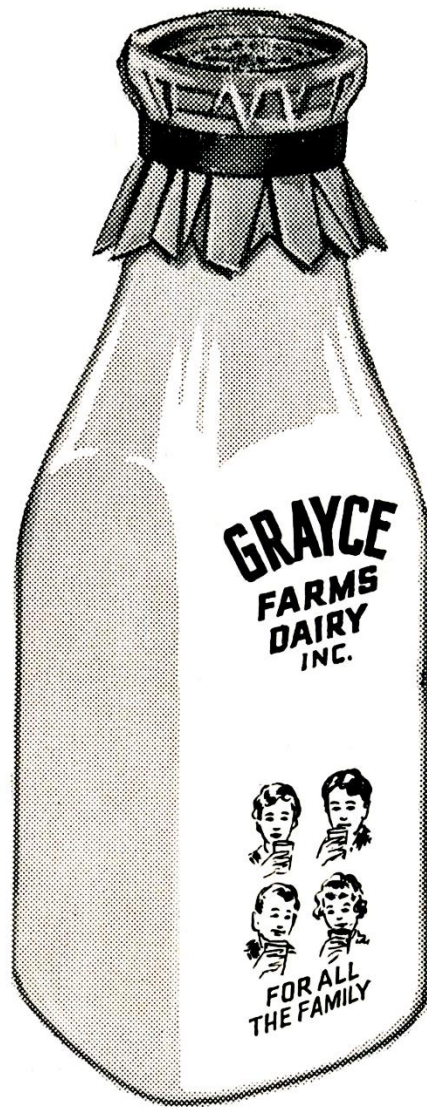

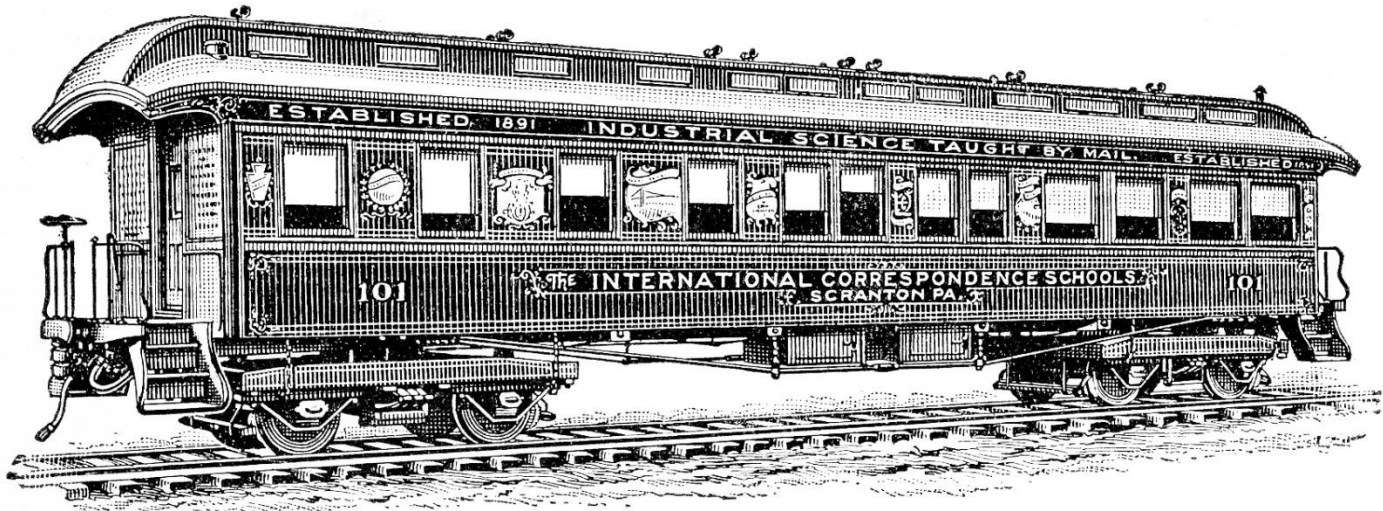

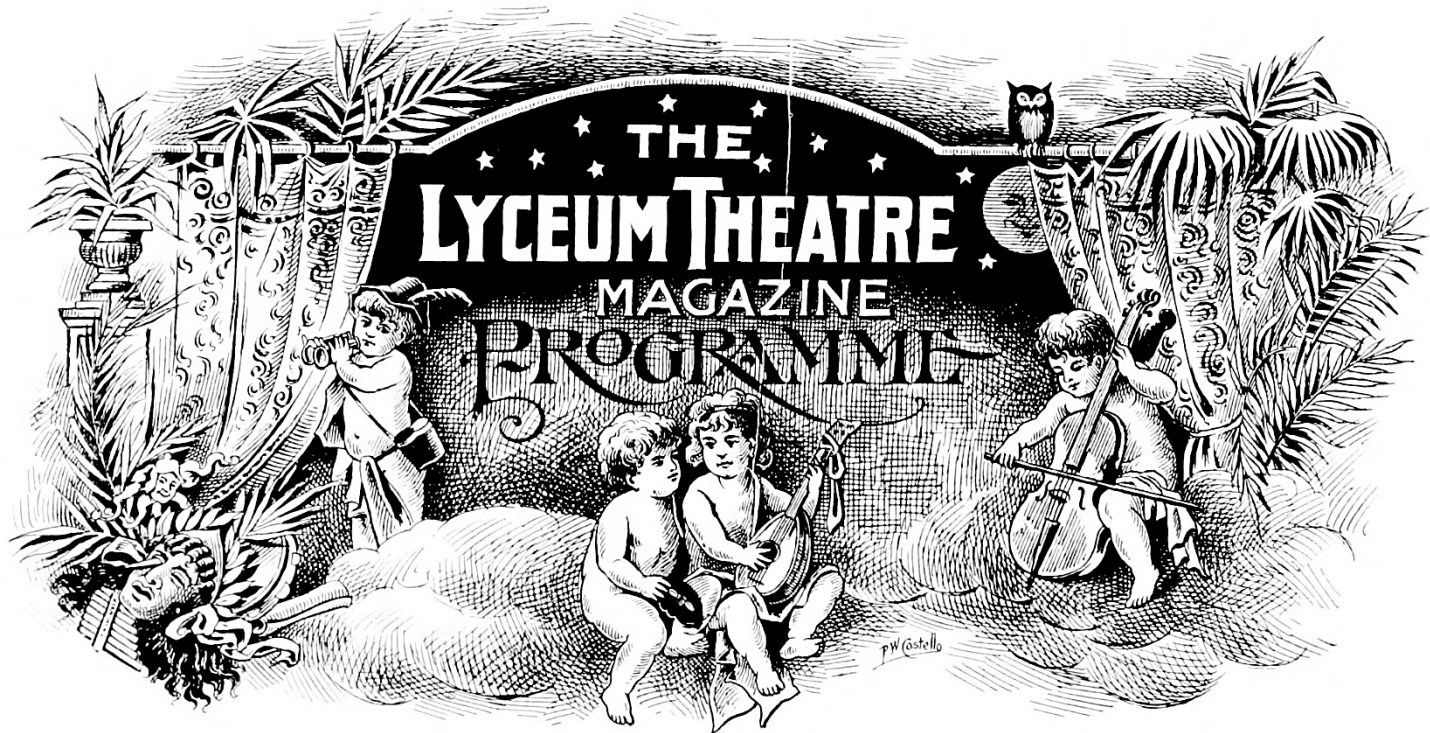

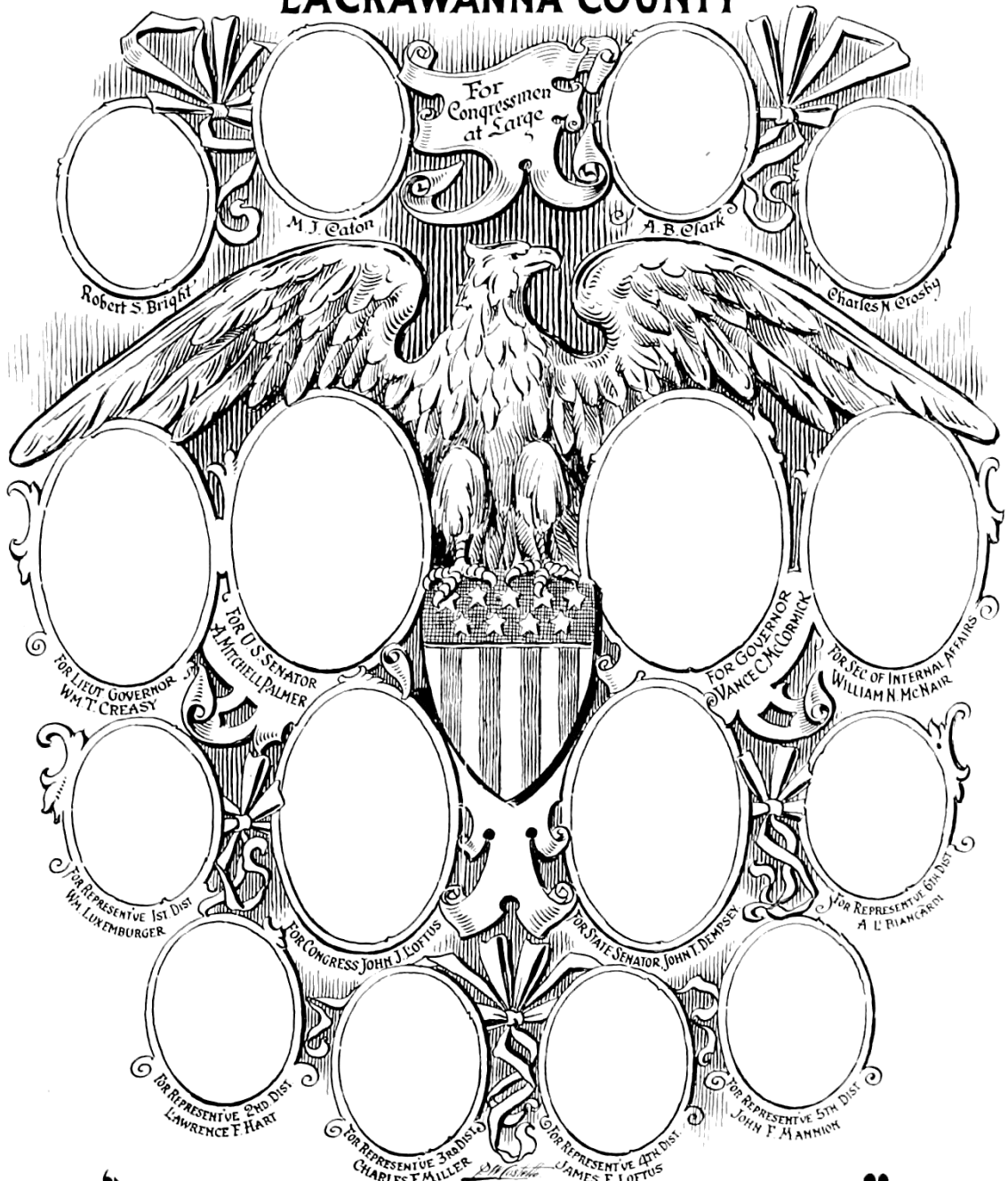
